Project Summary:

The General Shale / Kiwanis Crossroads Memorial Exhibit is an interactive sculptural exhibit including brick archways, engraved brick pavers and hand sculpted brick artwork.

Project Description

Darrell's Dream Boundless Playground® is designed to serve children and adults of all abilities and incorporates play environments that include physical, developmental and sensory activities. An interactive sculptural exhibit was incorporated into the center of the playground, giving recognition to those who were integral to the visioning and development of the playground while also integrating an educational and sensory component. The site includes a brick pathway with engraved sponsor bricks that leads through an archway into the exhibit. One interior wall includes a Friends of Warrior's Path logo panel and plaques for the two corporate sponsors of the exhibit, General Shale Brick and the Kiwanis Club of Kingsport. The other interior wall includes seven animal prints stamped into the brick with Braille identification below. The exterior of the exhibit includes four sculpted panels depicting the logos of the Tennessee State Parks and National Center for Boundless Playgrounds®, bluebirds, and a portrait of Darrell Rice for whom the park is named. The theme of the playground is "a turtle on a fence post - you know it had help to get there". This theme was integrated into the structure with a "fence post" located at the six corners of the structure with a turtle atop each one. General Shale Brick and Johnny Haggerman collaborated on the design and construction of the exhibit, with Johnny producing the art sketches and hand sculpting the brick for the panels, animal prints and fence posts.

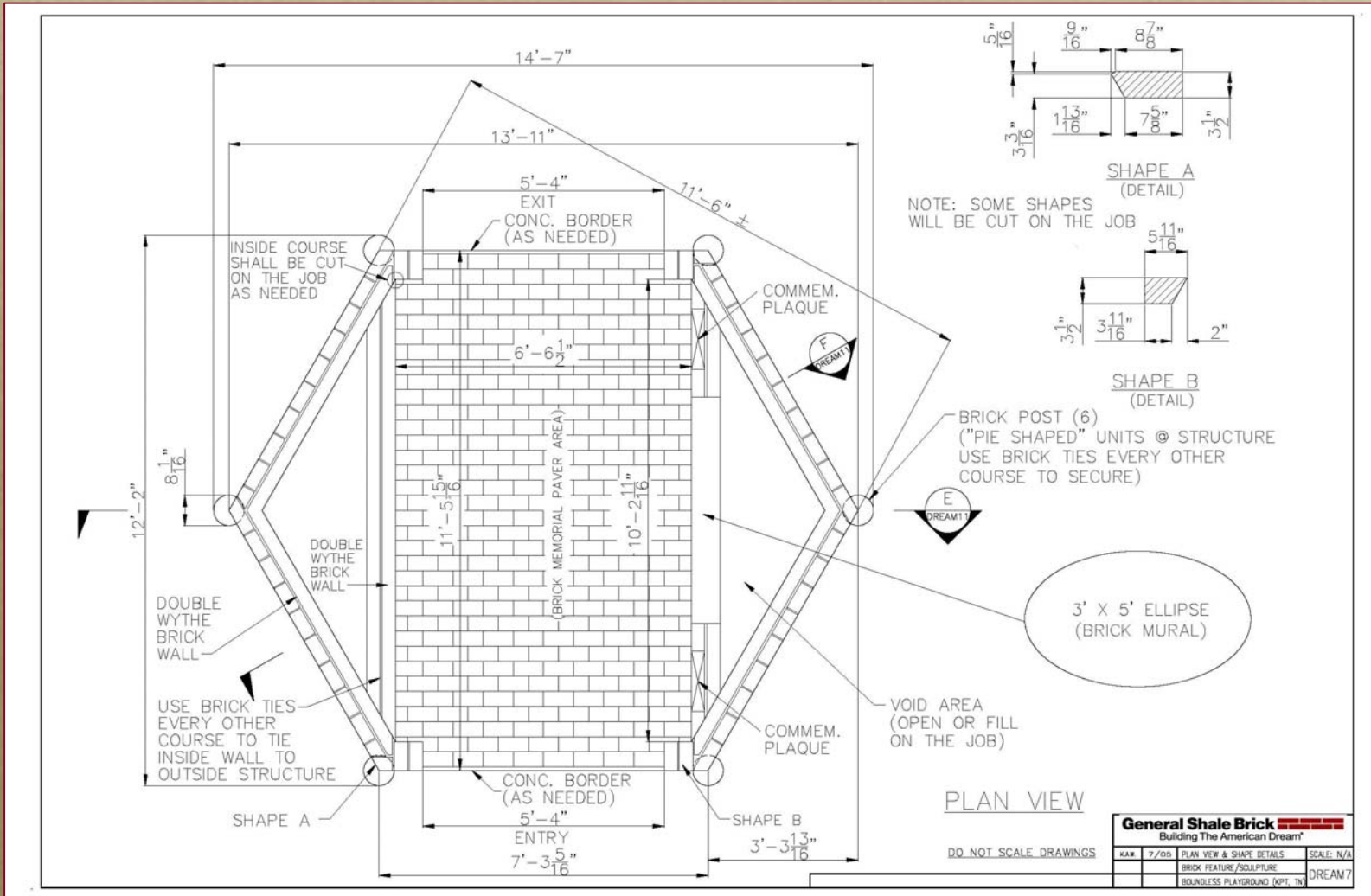

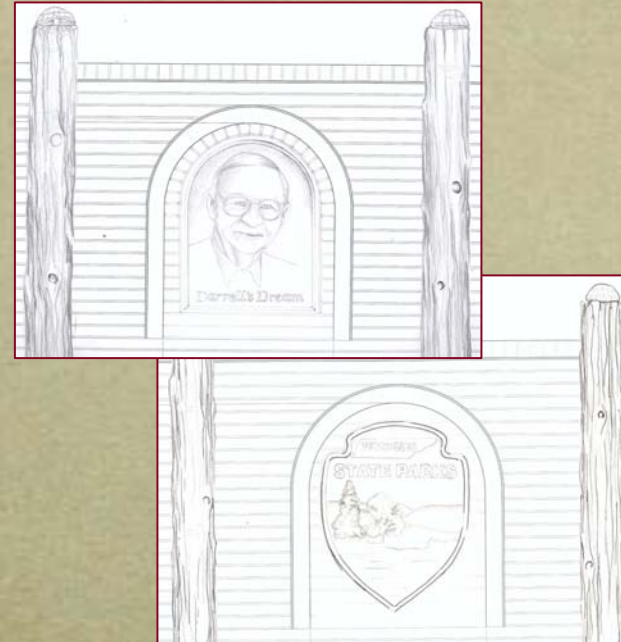
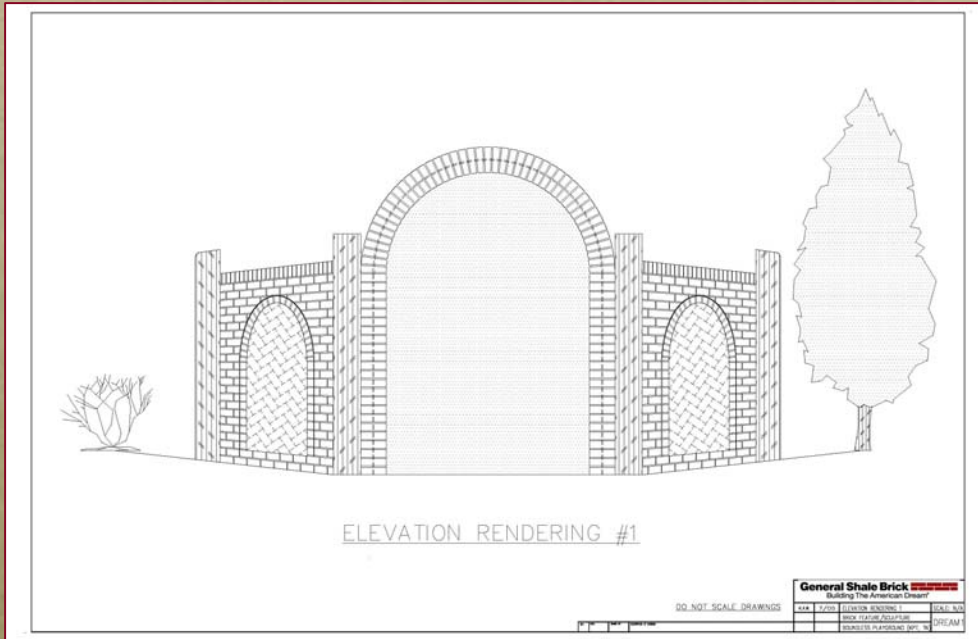
Floor Plan



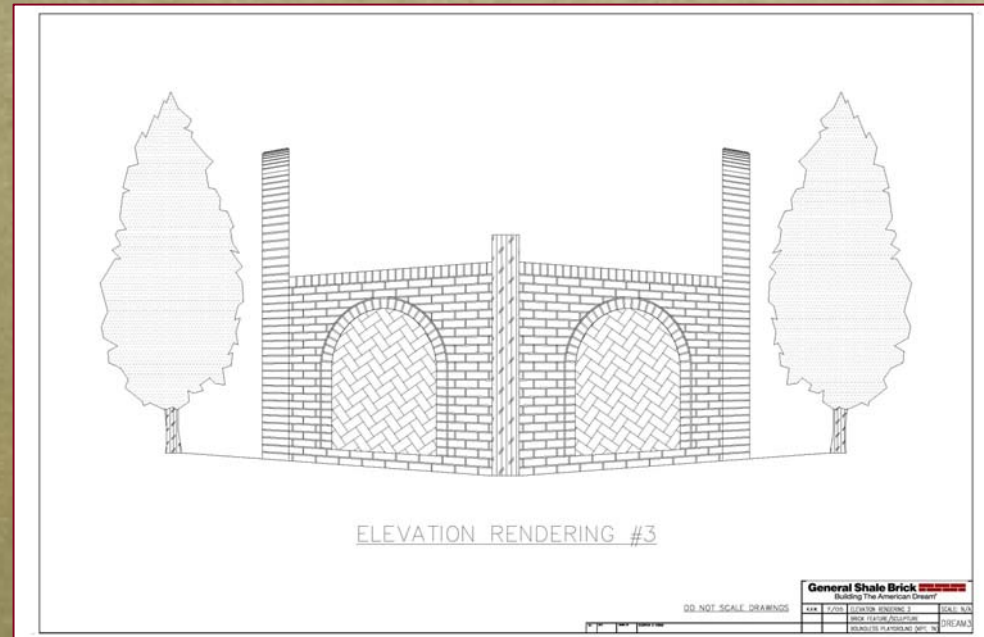
